

The United States Association of Collegiate Fencing Clubs (USACFC) is proud to announce that the 2016 Championships will be held in **Providence, RI on April 2-3.**

The organizers of the Championships are hiring referees for the two-day event.

Requirements: Officials should have working knowledge of all rule changes as of April 1, 2016. While USFA refereeing ratings are not required, referee experience is. Officials will be expected to wear USFA standard attire.

Date: April 2-3, 2016

LOC: Brown University, Providence, RI

Format: USACFC Format. Full details to be discussed at officials' meetings. Referees will be assigned to one weapon. Sabre will be separated into two flights.

Compensation: The USACFC will be paying \$125/day. In addition, we will pay a \$25 bonus to the referees assigned to the individual finals on Saturday (approx. four per weapon/gender event) and a \$25 bonus to those assigned to the gold and bronze medal squad matches on Sunday (two per event).

Lodging and travel: Referees from out of town will be housed in a hotel room (no more than two per room). Breakfast and Lunch will be provided on both days. Mileage will be paid for drivers who carpool with at least three officials /car.
